Thank you very much for considering Cancer Services for your donation. Given our limited warehouse space and the needs of our patients, we are providing information on what we are able to take as donations. **Please note that all donations need to come from a Smoke-Free home and Cancer Services reserves the right to refuse any donation.**

Medical Equipment: New or gently used and clean, rust-free medical equipment such as shower chairs, walkers, canes, rollators, portable ramps, bedside commodes, bed rails, electric hospital beds, lift chairs, wheelchairs, cushions, etc.

Nutrition: Unexpired supplemental or tube feeding nutrition such as Boost, Ensure, Carnation Instant Breakfast, and all types of tube feeding nutrition. We also accept protein bars and protein powder.

Medical Supplies: New supplies sealed in original packaging. We do not accept expired supplies or supplies that have yellowed with time. We accept ostomy pouches and ostomy supplies, bandages, dressing, medical tape, tracheotomy supplies, catheters and catheter supplies.

Incontinent Supplies: All supplies must be unused. They can be open but must be in new condition. We accept washable bed pads, pull-ups, briefs, chux, wipes, gloves, peri-fresh, etc.

Women's Boutique: All items must be clean and in like-new condition. We gladly accept hats, scarves, turbans, wigs, wig supplies, mastectomy bras, prosthetics, and post-surgical camisoles and supplies, lap blankets, etc.

Miscellaneous Items: Items that can be used to assist cancer patients through their journey such as blood pressure cuffs, pulse-ox devices, heating pads, reach assists, gait belts, sock aids, slide boards, mouth swabs, compression garments, face masks, no-rinse body bath, shampoo, lotion, alcohol swabs, gloves, twin sheet sets and blankets.

Items we DO NOT accept:

- Medications and pharmaceutical drugs
- Needles
- Diabetic Supplies
- Power wheelchairs or scooters
- Furniture (except lift chairs from a smoke-free home)
- Make-up
- Clothing or shoes
- Items from a smoking household
