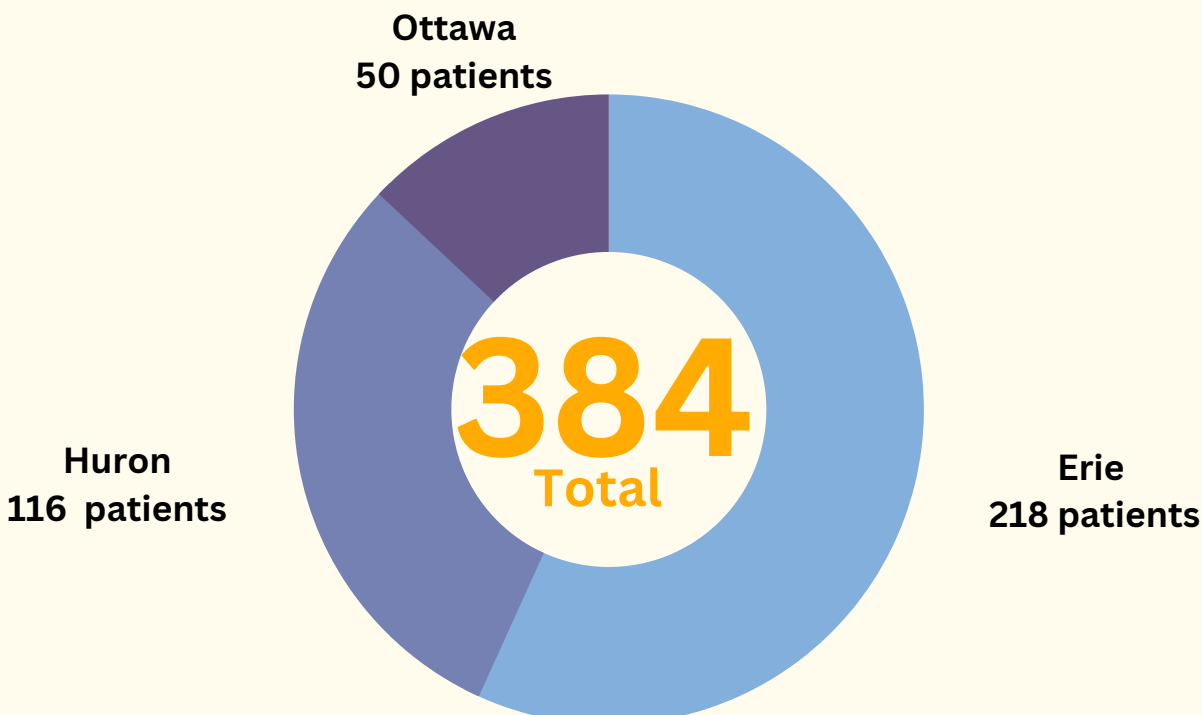

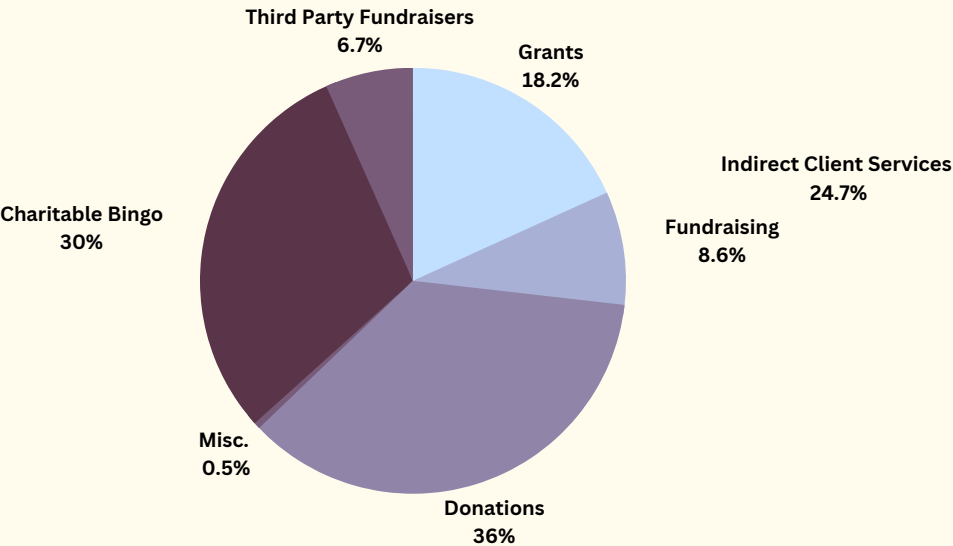

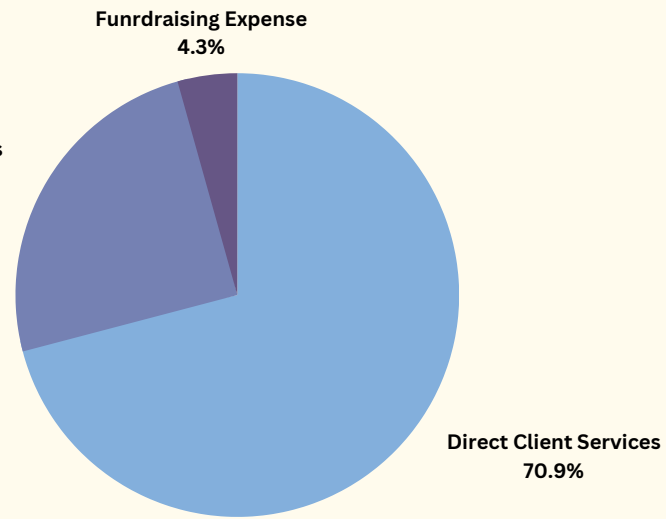
Number of patients served by county

Be an advocate and leader in cancer patient services.

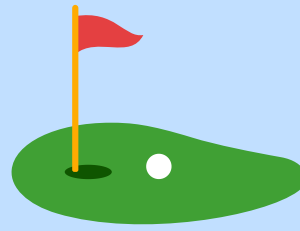
Our goal is to advocate for cancer patients in our community to ensure they have the programs, support, and assistance they need while facing a cancer diagnosis.

KNOW YOUR FAMILY HISTORY

Knowing your family medical history is essential in understanding your risk of developing certain diseases, including cancer. About 5-10% of all cancer are caused by inherited gene mutations, and many other cancers have a familial component. Therefore, it is essential to document your family medical history and share it with your healthcare provider.

First, ask your family members about their medical history, including any chronic illnesses, surgeries, and diagnoses. It's also important to ask about the age at which a family member was diagnosed and if they had any related conditions or symptoms. Knowing this information can help you and your healthcare provider determine if you are at an increased risk for certain diseases, including cancer. Once you have gathered this information, it's important to record it. You can use a family medical history form, which is available on our website. By knowing and documenting your family medical history, you can take proactive steps to reduce your risk of developing certain diseases, including cancer. For example, you may need to start screening for certain cancers at an earlier age or more frequently than someone without a history of the disease.

Knowing and recording your family medical history is important in understanding your risk for certain diseases. Take the time to ask the right questions and document the information so that you can work with your healthcare provider to take proactive steps to maintain your health.

ASK QUESTIONS LIKE

- **Have any family members had cancer? If so, which type of cancer, and at what age were they diagnosed?**
- **Have any family members had heart disease, stroke, or high blood pressure?**
- **Has anyone in the family had diabetes or other chronic illnesses?**
- **Are there any genetic disorders or conditions that run in the family?**
- **Has anyone in the family had surgeries, and if so, what type of surgeries?**
- **Are there any allergies that run in the family?**
